1. The Reason for the Condemnation (1-4)

Three ways that the Bible speaks of the sin of judgementalism:

1. Self-righteous judging: Believing that you would make different decisions were you to be in the shoes of the judged and elevating yourself because of this.
2. Grey area judging: Judging people for things that the Bible does not speak clearly about. (Rom. 14:1-10)
3. Hypocritical judging: Judging a person when you are guilty of the same things. (2b)
